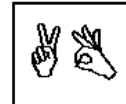

4. MW: Planning for Community Forum on Civilian Oversight on the Sheriff's Department
 - Assembly bill AB 1185 – passed and recently signed by the Gov
 - Currently , only attorney general has power over the Sheriff's office.
 - BOS only has budget power.
 - Under AB 1185 – two options
 - a. Commission with subpoena power
 - b. Office of an inspector general
 - Host a Community forum
 - a. Ask a number of organization to co-sponsor the event , MWC, ACLU, etc.
 - b. Ask a handful of speakers: Supervisor Rodoni, Sheriff, Legal Aid Marin, etc.
 - c. Give a report back to the BOS

Community comment: *George Pegelow volunteered to assist and suggested review Of the President's Task Force of 21st Century Policing.*

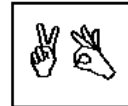
