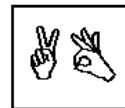

- 2) Public Comment on Items Not on the Agenda
Open time for public expression. The Commission will take public comment (up to 2 minutes per speaker) on all items not appearing on the agenda during this portion of the regular meeting. While members of the public are welcome to address the Commission, under the Brown Act, Commissioners may not deliberate or act on items not on the agenda, and generally may only listen.

Regular Business

The Commission will hold a discussion on an agenda item, at the end of the discussion, the Chair or Co-Chair will ask for public comment on that particular agenda item. The public will then have up to 2 minutes per speaker to speak on that particular agenda item before any action on the item is taken by the Commission.

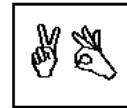
