Board Lauds Honorees

The Marin County Board of Supervisors has honored 139 volunteers and interns who made big impacts and completed their service. Board members passed individual resolutions of commendation on August 10.

Honorees served in 14 departments in a range of roles. Of the total, 101 were Marinterns who learned about careers in law, public health, agriculture, library services, and more. Surveyor Finds Facts on Historic Maps

The Marin County Free Library's California Room is full of significant collections, including 30,000 historic maps and surveys with an extensive unrecorded Marin County Map & Survey archive dating from 1849 to 1988.

Each week, Marin-Shares volunteer Phil Danskin, a

professional surveyor, serves several hours with the California Room archive, finding maps requested by other surveyors.

He scans, re-files, and emails the maps as part of his triple role as a volunteer map archive docent, researcher, and cataloguer. While this may sound mundane to an outsider, it is no easy feat—and the findings could lead to big changes for a home or town.

"Finding what was asked for is sometimes the most difficult part," explained Phil. "I've discovered duplicates, misindexed maps, and maps not in the best shape. And it's challenging to create a file for big tube maps, which are much too big to scan."

When not volunteering, Phil is a selfemployed land surveyor running a father/son business in Marin, and an active member of the Marin County chapter of the California Land Surveyors Association.

Phil's interest in surveying began early. "In high school I wanted to fly. And the opportunity [to learn surveying] presented itself when my flight instructor built an airport in Sonoma," he reminisced. The instructor asked Phil to help and "that was my first experience in surveying."

His career took him from flying over land to surveying properties in Marin County. He even made headlines in the Marin IJ. A special one was "Stake Upsets Old Lot Lines," when Phil discovered something that questioned modern-day property boundaries.

"While employed at Joseph Grippi & Associates, I discovered a survey stake that was set in 1888," he said. "There is a water cave for a spring that served the San Francisco Theological Seminary in San Anselmo. I searched with a metal detector and came upon an old buried barbed-wire fence." Phil removed two remnants of intersecting fencing and dug down about

18 inches. The 1888 field notes described a clump of stakes, with "one marked AWF," Phil said. "I found the stub of the stake, and a 1900 mint-condition dime buried there! Like a surveyor long ago said, 'I'll give you a dime if you find the right stake!"

For Phil, the most rewarding part of volunteering in the California Room is "finding a map or field notes that are key to resolving a boundary."

"Phil's expertise as a surveyor and his connections to the field, literally and figuratively, are key to creating accurate metadata," said Phil's staff supervisor, Librarian Carol Acquaviva of the California Room staff. "We are incredibly lucky to have someone with his specialized knowledge helping us provide access to this one-of-a-kind collection."
